It is important that funds are raised by **August 15**, or the plan will have to be scaled back causing the loss of 20% in matching New Market Tax Credit Funds (funds that do not have to be repaid).

# We Need 3 Million "Splashes" To Build Central Park!

## Aquatic Park Area

- **Master Blaster** – the "Wow Factor" water-coaster ride designed to be a crowd pleaser and is sure to bring water park enthusiasts to Huron from far-and-wide.
- **Leisure Pool** with zero-depth entrance making it handicap accessible and kid-friendly. Allows for changeable kiddy pool features.
- **Traditional Body Slide** is an alternative to the more aggressive ride of the Master Blaster.
- **Lazy River** where swimmers take a relaxing ride carried around a loop by a current.
- **Heated 8-Lane Competition & Recreation Pool** features a diving well with multi-level diving boards as well as a drop slide.
- **Turf Areas** with 50% more space for swim meets.
- **Bath House with Concession Stand** that is accessible from both the water park and outside the fence in the city park.
- **Sundecks** – ample areas around all aquatic features with loungers and sun umbrellas to enjoy the sun or the shade.
- **Private Coves** for Birthday Parties, Family Gatherings, etc.
- **Aquatic Center** capacity of up to 1500 visitors.

## Campus Center

- **Additional classrooms and lab space** for Huron Community Campus educational partners: Dakota Wesleyan University, Northern State University, Mitchell Technical Institute and Cornerstones Career Learning Center.
- **New Home** to Huron Parks & Rec Department.
- **Renovation of Campus Center** with ADA accessible restrooms and elevator to 2nd floor.

- **Community Rooms** with kitchen amenities for birthday parties, reunions, wedding receptions, family celebrations, etc.
- **Multi-Use rooms** for adult and youth arts & crafts programming.
- **Youth Activity Center** to encourage positive interaction of our youth and a healthy lifestyle through year-round fun recreational activities.
- **Interactive Outdoor Courtyard** for outdoor movies, youth murals and a monument to recognize Central Park donors.
- **Community Education Classrooms** for expanded adult education programs.
- **15-minute "quick-park"** area in front of Campus Center on 9th Street for activity sign-ups.

## Premier Park Area

- **Off-Street Parking** for over 300 vehicles.
- **1/3 mile Walking Track** surrounding aquatic center as well as additional trails and resting areas throughout park.
- **Traditional and Sensory** playground areas.
- **Recreation** - Basketball/Tennis Court, Bocce Ball Courts and Horseshoe Pits.
- **Three Picnic Shelters** within the new city park.
- **Community Flower Gardens** for local individuals and organizations.
- **College Courtyard** in honor of the 122 year history of Huron College/University in our community.
- **Victory Bell and Cornerstones** from college buildings displayed throughout park.
- **Three-Layer Sound Buffering** between aquatic site and surrounding neighbors.
- **Over 100 trees** from the existing campus site incorporated into the new park design.
