YOUR MISSION: Use PEEPS marshmallow treats to create a scene that demonstrates the Celebration of Spring!

- Submit dioramas and entry forms at the circulation desk in the library between Monday, April 1 and Saturday, April 13.
- Diorama must be self contained and roughly the size of a shoebox or no larger than 18" x 18".
- All visible portions of the diorama must be decorated.
- At least one marshmallow PEEP must be present in your diorama.
- Dioramas will be judged for creativity, humor, workmanship, and visual appeal. Submissions will be judged by staff of Office Peeps. The PEEPlE's Choice will be chosen by the public.
- Voting for public opens on Monday, April 15 at 9:00 a.m. and ends Saturday, April 20 at 5:00 p.m.
- Winners will be announced on Monday, April 22.
- There will be a first and second prize awarded for each entry category. Winners need not be present to win.
- Please use discretion with diorama content. The library reserves the right to reject entries based on content.
- Dioramas will be on display until Saturday, April 27. Huron Public Library reserves the right to dispose of dioramas that aren't picked up by Monday, April 29.
- By entering the diorama contest, you are giving the library permission to take pictures of your creations and share them online and through promotional materials.
- We will try to safeguard your creations, but we are required to say that the Huron Public Library is not responsible for any diorama damage or theft.

Prize Categories

First and Second prizes will be awarded for each category.

- **Families & Groups** (multiple creators on one diorama)
- **Kids** (Grades Preschool-3rd Grade)
- **Tweens** (4th-6th Grade)
- **Teens** (7th-12th Grade)
- **Adults** (ages 18 & up)
- **Huron Public Library Staff**
