## Rules and Regulations of Early Release Lalapalooza

- 1. Your child will be supervised at the designated areas of the library from 1:45pm 3:30pm. At 3:30pm, it is **required** that the parent/guardian or authorized person will pick-up child inside the library.
- 2. Children will be expected to follow the stated library polices found at <a href="https://www.huronsd.com/living-in-huron/huron-public-library">https://www.huronsd.com/living-in-huron/huron-public-library</a>.
- 3. Huron Public Library follows a zero-tolerance policy in regards to conduct and behavior.
- 4. A student who fails to obey will receive a warning. The second offense the student will be immediately removed from the program, parent/guardian will be notified to pick-up the child. Further participation in Early Release Lalapalooza will be determined by library staff and parent/guardian will be notified.
- 5. A parent/guardian will be called to pick up a child who is sick or injured. Medicine will be not administered.
- 6. The library staff will not administer any medication that a child may require. Parent/guardian are required to administer medical needs and care.
- 7. A snack may be served at Early Release Lalapalooza. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to provide the student with an appropriate snack for those who have restrictions due to allergies/sensitivities.
- 8. Children preschool and younger **may not** be left unattended at Early Release Lalapalooza. A parent/guardian or caregiver (defined as 6<sup>th</sup> grade and older) is required to be in attendance and supervise child. (See library policy for more information)
- 9. I agree to waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages, for death, personal injury, loss, lawsuits, expenses, and other liability of any kind, which my child may have or which may hereafter accrue as a result of my child's participation in this program against their person or entity whether such injury or damage was foreseeable. This acknowledgement of and assumption of risk and release shall be binding upon heirs and assigns.
- 10. A new form will be required each school year.
