Sealed Bids will be received by the City of Huron, South Dakota, in the City Hall located at 239 Wisconsin Avenue Southwest, until 2 P.M., CST, Tuesday, December 13, 2011, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for the furnishing of all labor, materials, and all else necessary for the following:

Huron Aquatic Center

In general, Work consists of the following approximate quantities:

- 10,088 +/- SF 8-Lane 50-Meter Competition Pool ranging in depth from 3'-6" to 12'-6". Diving boards, drop slide, and play feature. Pool equipment includes pumps, regenerative media filter, chemical feed systems, etc.
- 6,400 +/- SF Leisure Pool ranging in depth from 0 feet to 3'-9". Assorted water play features. Pool equipment includes pumps, regenerative media filter, chemical feed system, etc.
- 7,251 +/- SF Lazy River Swimming Pool ranging in depth from 2'-9" to 3'-6". Assorted water play features and water slides. Pool equipment includes pumps, regenerative media filter, chemical feed system, etc.
- Masonry Bath House/Staff/Concession and Pool Mechanical Buildings.
- Park Improvements includes landscaping, concrete trail, picnic shelters, playground equipment, etc.
- Miscellaneous Site work items, including but not limited to: concrete sidewalk, concrete pool deck, earthwork, grading, drain tile, storm water piping, sanitary sewer and water services, exterior lighting, fencing, etc.

Such bond to be issued by a surety authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota, payable to the City of Huron, as a guaranty that the Bidder will enter into a contract with the City of Huron.

The Owner reserves the right to retain the deposits of the 3 lowest Bidders for a period not to exceed 60 days after the date and time set for the Opening of Bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein, and further reserves the right to award the Contract to the best interests of the Owner.
