

!E-Alerts

Available by Text or Email

The City of Huron has implemented a new Electronic Alerts feature called **!E-Alerts** for residents to receive alerts and public announcements via text message and/or email. [This new feature replaces Nixle](#) which the city has used in the past, and is provided without charge. Users will not receive any advertising, spam, or junk mail by subscribing to **!E-Alerts**. You will only receive official communications by your choice of text messaging, email, or both.

Subscribe to !E-Alerts

1. Go to: www.huronsd.com
2. Click on: **!E-Alerts Sign Up** (located near the top of the page)
3. **TEXT MESSAGE:** To receive notifications via text message: click send notifications to my cell phone, enter cell phone number, select cell phone carrier, click subscribe, enter the security code and click submit. The following carriers support the **!E-Alerts** program: AT&T, Sprint, Verizon, T-Mobile, Qwest.
4. **EMAIL:** To receive notifications through email: click send notifications to my email address, enter email address, click subscribe, enter the security code and click submit.

Notifications Include:

- ❖ **Alerts** --- snow alerts, crime alerts, weather events, water main breaks, street closings, road work, etc.
- ❖ **Announcements** --- reminders of major community events such as Harvest Fest, Parade of Lights, Wheel Jam, etc.

Unsubscribe At Any Time

There is also an “Unsubscribe” option if you want to discontinue this service. Go to www.huronsd.com, click on **!E-Alerts Sign Up** to select which option you want to discontinue, enter cell phone or email information, click Unsubscribe, enter the security code and click Submit.
