

Our Rubble Site/Transfer Station requires all items to be sorted. You will need to sort the materials you are disposing of either before you arrive or once you enter the site. Different types of waste must be separated to different areas on the site. They are:

- **Cardboard:** Cardboard can be recycled if it is clean and not waxed on the inside. We do not charge for this if it is recyclable.
- **Garbage Baler Building \$60/Ton:** Household garbage, all types of paper, sheet plastic, food & beverage containers, burn ashes, computer monitors, TVs, insulation, fluorescent bulbs, clothing, books and other similar materials.
- **Hazardous Waste Disposal:** The past few years the City of Huron, in a joint effort with Beadle County, the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), and the State of SD, has offered a Household Hazardous Waste Disposal for area residents to dispose of stains, varnishes, sealers, latex/oil paints, antifreeze, gasoline, car/household batteries, cleaners, solvents, and waxes. An Ag chemical disposal was also held in conjunction with the hazardous waste disposal. Due to the success of this program we hope to hold a Hazardous Waste Disposal annually. Please watch for future advertisements regarding possible Hazardous Waste Disposal.
- **Metal Pile \$15/Ton:** Bikes, cast iron, lawn chairs with webbing, water heaters, metal siding/gutters, metal pipe/tubing, lawn mowers, empty metal paint cans, stoves, refrigerators, freezer, washers and dryers. FREON UNITS (including dehumidifiers) have a separate drop off site plus a Freon removal charge of \$7.00 and \$1.00 Capacitor removal fee per unit.
- **Paint:** Paint cans must have the lids removed and the contents completely dried out in order to be accepted at the Rubble Site. If the paint has not solidified, add floor dry, cat litter or newspaper to absorb the paint.
- **Prohibited Waste Materials:** Absolutely no Liquids, Waste Oil, Hazardous Waste (chemicals, lawn fertilizer, Contaminated Soil or Lead Acid Batteries).
- **Rubble/Furniture Pile \$15/Ton:** Furniture, carpet, heavy plastics, mattresses, glass, most doors, sheet rock, plywood, particle board, siding, shingles, all treated wood, vinyl, fiberglass, insulation, computer hard drives, copiers, printers, microwaves, toaster ovens, porcelain, hoses, weights. If items are in bags they need to be emptied. Concrete, rock, cover dirt and bricks are considered rubble and will need to be placed in a separate rubble pile.
- **Tree/Wood Pile \$10/Ton:** Trees, branches, untreated wood (no paint, stain, glue, plywood or chipboard).
- **Vehicle Batteries:** There is a \$1 Fee per auto battery.

DISPOSAL FEES & MISCELLANEOUS FEES

Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Equipment: The cooling compound (FREON) will be removed at the site by a certified technician. There will be a \$7.00 per compressor fee for all units that have the compressor still in them, plus a \$1.00 condenser removal fee.

NOTE: It is against Federal Law to intentionally release cooling compounds (fluorocarbons) into the atmosphere, and individuals who do so are subject to fines of up to \$10,000 plus jail time.
