

## Huron Area Chamber & Visitors Bureau Agriculture Committee Scholarship Application

This scholarship being made available to any graduating high school senior who is planning to enroll in post-secondary education at any University or Technical Institute in South Dakota. The scholarship will be paid to the financial office at the appropriate school at the beginning of the second semester. All students living in the Huron area are eligible, preference will be given to students majoring in a degree that is specifically related to agriculture.

## Applicant Requirements

- 1. Complete the following application in full. Applications may be legibly hand written, typed, or computer reproduced. Use additional sheets as necessary.
- 2. Include applicant's most recent high school transcript with current GPA and class rank.
- 3. Include a letter of recommendation from an academic advisor such as teacher, guidance counselor, principal or advisor. The letter of recommendation should attest to the applicant's character, scholastic, leadership qualities, as well as finacial need. The letter of recommendation should be in a sealed envelope, and must be included with the application.
- 4. Upon completion of requirements, the application should be sent to the Ag Scholarship Committee, Huron Chamber & Visitors Bureau, 1725 Dakota Ave S, Huron, SD 57350. Applications must be postmarked no later than **April 1, 2021**.

NOTE: By submitting this scholarship application, applicants authorize the use of personal information to the Committee in all publicity and press releases. Scholarship winners will be announced in May. The recipiants will be asked to provide their Social Security Numbers before payment is made to the school. No interviews will be held in conjunction with the scholarship application.
