

Declaring a Snow Removal Alert

A “Snow Removal Alert” means that an authorized city official has declared that snow removal operations on the public streets will begin. The local news media will announce when a snow removal alert is declared.

Established priorities:

1. Core area of the city.
2. Police, Fire and Rescue calls that need assistance, such as safe passage through icing or deep snow. In the event of a health, safety or welfare emergency this priority may become number one.
3. All other streets not in the core area or emergency routes.

Core Area

The “Core Area” consists of streets in the downtown area, as follows: Bounded on the north by Market St. and on the east by Iowa Ave. SE from Market St. to 3rd St. SE and Idaho Ave. from 3rd St. SE to 5th St. SE and bounded on the south by 5th St. from Idaho Ave. SE to Wisconsin Ave. SW and 6th St. SW from Wisconsin Ave. SW to Ohio Ave SW and bounded on the west by Ohio Ave SW from 6th St. SW to Market St.; to include the entire roadway of those designate streets and avenues.

No Parking on Alternate Days

After the Core Area and Emergency Routes are cleared of snow, the other city streets will be cleared. East-West streets or courts entering off of an East-West street will be cleared on even numbered calendar days. North-South streets or courts entering off of a North-South street will be cleared on odd numbered calendar days. No parking is allowed during a snow alert until snow is cleared from curb to curb on that particular street.

Parking Tickets

City ordinances which prohibit parking during a snow removal alert are in effect and enforced on public streets during snow removal operations. The City of Huron Police Department is authorized to ticket and/or tow away any motor vehicle or vehicles found in violation. Tickets issued will be in the amount of \$35.00. (Please see Resolution No. 2009-01 for complete list of noncompliance fees.)

Termination of a Snow Removal Alert

A Snow Removal Alert will terminate on a particular street as soon as that street has been plowed and cleared of snow from curb to curb. Normal parking can then resume in that area.

Snow Hints

To avoid receiving a ticket or having your vehicle towed, please familiarize yourself with the parking requirements. The city suggests that drivers make arrangements in advance for off-street parking.

Removal from Sidewalks

The tenants or occupants of any building, lot or land bordering on any street, within the city, where there is any sidewalk, shall within forty-eight hours after a snow accumulation event, cause any loose or compacted snow to be removed from public sidewalks to a width of at least forty-eight inches.

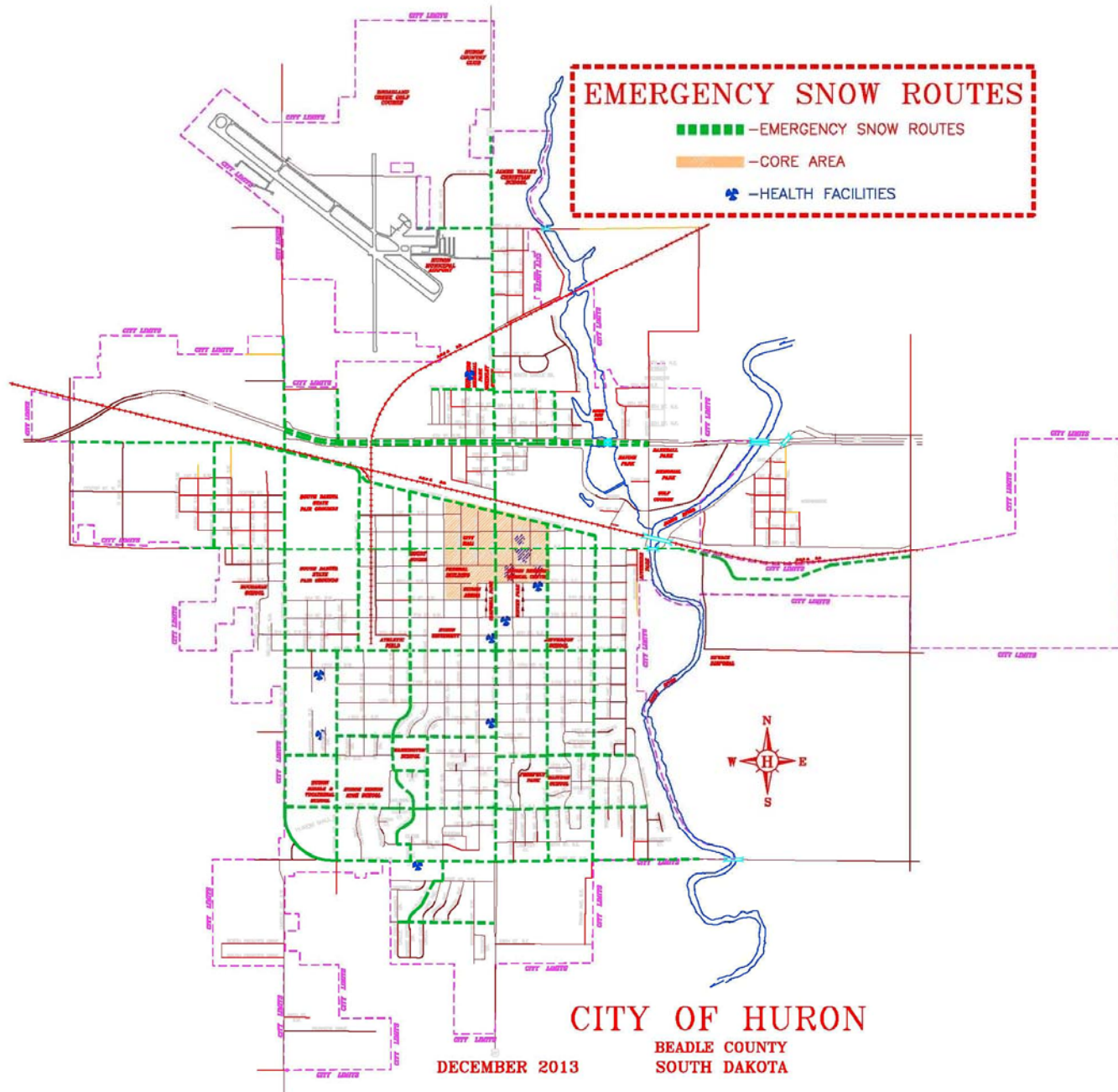

City Ordinance 16.30.020 - No parking on emergency routes in the city when snowfall exceeds two inches. No person shall park or allow to remain parked any vehicle on any public street designated as an emergency route as defined by Section 16.30.010(2) when snowfall is greater than two inches until that street or portion has been plowed and cleared of snow accumulation, curb to curb, after which normal parking may be resumed until the next snow fall in excess of two inches.



Before parking on an Emergency Route or in the Core Area be especially aware of weather conditions. Do not park in the following Snow Emergency Routes if snow is predicted:

- ◆ 15th St N from the Airport to Dakota Ave
- ◆ 7th St NW
- ◆ 4th St N from west city limits to east city limits including that portion which is four-lane
- ◆ Old Hwy 14 from west city limits to Market St
- ◆ Market St to Frank Ave
- ◆ 3rd St S from west city limits to east city limits
- ◆ 9th St S from Lincoln Ave to Lawnridge Ave
- ◆ 15th St SW from Lincoln Ave to Arizona Ave
- ◆ 14th St SW from Arizona Ave to Dakota Ave
- ◆ 16th St SW from McDonald Dr to McClellan Dr
- ◆ McClellan Dr from 16th St SW to 14th St SW
- ◆ 15th St SE from Dakota Ave to Riverview Dr
- ◆ 18th St S from Lincoln Ave to Riverview Dr
- ◆ Lincoln Ave from north city limits to 21st St S and 21st St/Centennial Rd to east city limits
- ◆ Arizona Ave N from 7th St N to 4th St N
- ◆ Arizona Ave S from 9th St S to 21st St S
- ◆ Nevada Ave S from Market St to 9th St S
- ◆ Colorado Ave/McDonald Dr from Market St to 20th St S and east to Campbell Dr and south to 21st St S
- ◆ Dakota Ave from north city limits to south city limits, except between the intersection of Dakota Ave and Market St to the intersection of Dakota Ave and 5th St (which is in the designated core area of the city)
- ◆ Idaho Ave S from Market St to 21st St S
- ◆ Frank Ave from Market St to 21st St S
- ◆ Pennington Ave from 3rd St SW to Old Hwy 14
- ◆ Starting at 21st Street SW, South on Ohio to 22nd Street, West on 22nd Street to McClellan, South on McClellan to 24th Street then all of 24th Street from McDonald Avenue to Dakota Avenue.
