

Students have two options when applying for admission.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING (STUDENTS WHO WISH TO TAKE CLASSES WITHOUT APPLYING FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID)

- Students who do not wish to pursue a degree or federal financial assistance can apply as a special student. Students in this category should fill out the [non-degree application](#), and [immunization form](#). These completed forms should be dropped off at 939 Ohio Ave SW, Huron 57350 or sent to sochsner@huronsd.com. Do not send the forms directly to NSU.
- Once students have registered, all communication and further instructions will be sent to you at the email address you provided on the registration form.

DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS (STUDENTS WHO WISH TO EARN THE ENTIRE DEGREE AT HCC AND/OR RECEIVE FEDERAL STUDENT AID)

- Students who wish to pursue a degree and federal financial assistance must apply as a degree seeking student and meet the SD Board of Regents Admission Requirements. The admission procedures are as follows:
 - A. Fill out the South Dakota Common Application Form available at the Huron Community Campus (do not fill out the online version without first contacting HCC at 353-8518).
 - B. Pay \$20.00 non-refundable application fee
 - C. Submit:
 1. Official high school transcript including class rank and cumulative grade point average or GED scores
 2. ACT scores (waived if student is 22 years or older)
 3. College transcripts if previously attended other colleges.
