3. Late/incomplete applications will not be considered unless there are no other eligible applicants.

4. If completing your application online, mail or fax a copy of your unofficial transcript to the above address or number by the above deadline.

Eligibility Rules and Disclaimers:

- 1. Up to \$5,000 in scholarship funds *may* be available
- 2. An applicant must either be a volunteer or be a direct family member of a volunteer or landowner involved in the 2016 Ringneck Festival and Bird Dog Challenge. (Direct family member is defined as a spouse, sibling, parent or grandparent)
- 3. An applicant must be currently in good standing ("C" average or better) at a high school or an accredited college or qualified technical institute.
- 4. The scholarship committee reserves the right to provide one or more scholarships, in varying amounts, to qualified applicants.
- 5. If there are no qualified applicants, the scholarship committee will forego providing scholarships.
- 6. Failure to acknowledge acceptance of the award will result in award forfeiture.
- 7. Scholarship funds are divided between the fall and spring semesters and paid directly to the recipient's institution. The final payment will be forfeited if the recipient has withdrawn from the program.
- 8. If a recipient graduates in December, he/she must provide written proof of this fact and then he/she will receive all of the scholarship funds in the fall semester.
- 9. Falsification of information or violation of rules will result in withdrawal of all remaining scholarship funds.
